

Children will need to bring to school:

1. 1 gallon Ziploc Bag of extra clothes. (Underwear, shorts, short sleeve top, socks, foot covering)
2. Light jacket to leave at school for the week. Please label with your child's name.
3. (Full Time children only) Bedding for nap. All bedding needs to be in a zippered bag or back pack. (One fitted crib sheet, small blanket that covers the child while sleeping, small travel pillow and one stuffed animal will be allowed if they stay at school all week.) Please bring things that can be easily washed.
4. Lunch with two snacks. The school will have emergency snack supply only.
5. **NO TOYS** can be brought to school at this time.
6. Bring a refillable water bottle with your child's name on it. It will be kept in their cubby.
7. Please have your child wear a mask into the school. We will be encouraging masks while inside. Masks will not be worn at recess, lunch or nap times. (Teachers will be wearing masks or a face shield.) I encourage you to take your child to pick out a mask that they like and practice wearing it before school starts. We want to do everything we can to protect our students and staff.

When children arrive at school:

1. Anyone walking into the school needs to have a mask on.
2. Children will have their temperature taken by a no touch thermometer
3. There will be some questions asked of the caregiver. These will be documented.
 - a. Has the child has a fever, cough, difficulty breathing or other signs of illness within the last 24 hours)
 - b. Has the child or anyone in the immediate family had any exposure to another individual with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 cases
 - c. Has the child been given any fever reducing medicine in the last 24 hours.
4. Sign children in. Smartcare has been modified to allow for a no touch sign in. 1. Open app. 2. Click the sign in and out button at the bottom of the screen. 3. Hold your phone over the QR code. 4. Slide the button. 5. Sign your name on the screen. If you don't have your phone then sign your child in on the clipboard on the table in the walkway. Parents are encouraged to bring their own pen. I will have two cups for the pens. One will say used and one will say new. After you use the pen please put it in the used cup. We will then disinfect them to be used another day.
5. Parents can walk their child to the classroom in the big building, but not into the room. Parents with children in the small building will walk children to the umbrellas. Each class will have an assigned bench with an umbrella.
6. Children will wash hands as soon as they enter the room.
7. On Friday (or the child's last day of the week) afternoon the child's belongings will be placed outside of their classroom. Each class will have a designated area. Please take them home and wash them so they can come back on Monday.

Pease notify the school . . .

1. Exposure of Coved 19 by child or immediate family member. Please keep your child home for two weeks. They may return if no symptoms have shown up.
2. Diagnosed with Covid19. Child must stay home until clearance has been given by their doctor.

Covid19 exposure. .

1. Families at the school will be notified of exposure, and the classroom that was exposed.
2. The health department and state licensing will be notified. We will then be under their guidance.
3. The classroom will close for 48 hours for cleaning.
